Reading of the Law

LEADER: Hear God's good and perfect will for your life:

He that loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me. And whoever loves a son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.

Confession of God's People

ALL: Who will grant unto me that you will come into my heart and intoxicate it, so that I may forget my evils and embrace my one Good, You? What are You to me? Be merciful, that I may speak. What am I myself for You, that You do command my love for You, and, unless I give it, are angry with me and threaten enormous afflictions? Is it a small thing in itself if I fail to love You? Ah me! Tell me, in Your mercy, O Lord, my God, what You are to me. 'Say to my soul: I am your salvation." So speak that I may hear. Behold the ears of my heart before You, O Lord; open them and say to my soul: 'I am your salvation.' May I pursue this voice and grasp You. Assurance of God's Pardon From Romans 1:16-17

LEADER: For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith"

Confession of Faith From Westminster Shorter Catechism 33-35

LEADER: What is justification?

ALL: Justification is an act of God's free grace, in which he pardons all our sins, and accepts us as righteous in his sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, and received by faith alone.

LEADER: What is adoption?

ALL: Adoption is an act of God's free grace, whereby we are received into the number, and have a right to all the privileges, of the sons of God.

LEADER: What is sanctification?

ALL: Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.
