Assurance of God's Pardon From Revelation 12:10-11

LEADER: And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God. And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death.

Confession of Faith From Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 5

LEADER: According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both now and in eternity: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

ALL: God requires that his justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of this justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

LEADER: Can we make this payment ourselves?

ALL: Certainly not. Actually, we increase our debt every day.

LEADER: What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?

ALL: One who is a true and righteous man, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God.
